Craters Mountain Bike Park is a purpose-built mountain bike park with around 50km of bike trails to suit all abilities.

All trails run in and out of exotic pine and eucalyptus plantations, with some stunning views of Lake Taupo and the Waikato River.

The volcanic pumice soils allow for year-round riding with free draining qualities that are not found anywhere else in New Zealand.

Please arrange your own Bike Park Visitor Membership and bike hire (if applicable).

Participants must supply and wear their own helmet and covered shoes.

Optional safety equipment: gloves, knee and elbow pads, etc.
